Specific Conditions:

The Authorization shall be complied under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and the rules made there under. The Authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer, Authorized by the prescribed authority.

1. HCF shall comply with the direction issued by Board vide letter No H-58049/C-6/Sa-35/Covid-19/2021 dated 28.01.2021 in compliance of Hon'ble NGT order in Original Application No. 72/2020 dated 18.01.2021...

..."In compliance with the Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016, every biomedical waste management facility must With regard to the implementation of Biomedical Waste Management Rule, 2016, installation of ETP is mandatory for above 10-bedded hospitals."

2. HCF shall comply with the provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 & Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

3. This consent is only valid if the hospital is located in conforming area as per Master Plan of the city.

4. The Authorized person shall not rent, lend, transfer or otherwise transport the Bio Medical waste without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.

5. It is duty of the Authorized person to take prior permission of the Board to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.

6. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment of working condition as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.

7. Bio Medical waste shall not be mixed with other waste.

8. Bio Medical waste shall be segregated into containers, bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule I. Prior to its storages, transportation, treatment and disposal. The Containers shall be labeled according to schedule IV.

9. No untreated bio medical waste shall be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours

10. You shall submit an annual report to the U.P. Pollution Control Board in from IV by 31st January every year. And include information about the categories and quantities of Bio Medical waste during the preceding year.

11. You shall maintain records related to the generation, collection, reception storage, Transportation, treatment and disposal and or any form of handling of Bio Medical Waste in accordance with rule and guidelines, all records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the Board at any time.

12. It is within the power and functions of U.P. Pollution Control Board to modify, revoke the terms and conditions of Authorization and issued under the Rule 10 of the Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.

13. You are hereby directed to comply the stipulated above mentioned conditions and submit the compliance report and steps taken in this regard within a month so that capacity of the facility may be verified failing which the authorization may be revoked and necessary legal proceeding shall be initiated.

14. The occupier shall ensure compliance of Consent granted by Board under the provisions of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act. 1974 as amended and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act. 1981 as amended.

3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
6. The Unit will file the renewal application at least 2 months prior to the expiry of this Order
